

CPWL Pipe Crossing Process



The following process applies for all on-farm pipe and cables crossing CPWL pipelines

1. CPWL has issued:
 - CPWL Pipe Crossing Best Practise Guidelines
 - CPWL Pipe Crossing Application Form (including):
 - Stage 1:- Contact details and location map
 - Stage 2:- Proposed crossing details
2. Landowner /Designers are to fill out the Stage 1 of CPWL's Pipe Crossing Application Form and submit this to CPWL at operations@CPWL.co.nz .
3. CPWL will then issue the Landowner/Designer with as-built information on CPWL pipeline for the farm area requested.
4. Landowner/Designer are to complete their crossing design and submit Stage 2 of CPWL's Pipe Crossing Application Form and submit this to CPWL at operations@cpwl.co.nz.
5. Should designers not be able to achieve the "Pipe Crossing Best Practise Guidelines" they can discuss these with CPWL and agree alternatives with suitable mitigation measures to ensure both pipes are protected from damage.
6. CPWL will issue a pipe crossing permit detailing any specific restriction or agreed design mitigation measures within the pipe easement area.
7. The Landowner is to provide CPWL 48 notice of the physical works being carried out to allow CPWL to inspect the work while it is being done.
